CHECK LIST

The following is an outline of application procedures for **nationals of Kiribati, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tuvalu, Tonga, Nauru, Vanuatu, Papua New Guinea, Palau, Fiji, Marshall Islands, and Micronesia** who wish to apply for a multiple-entry visa as a temporary visitor. The visa is for the purpose of tourism, business affairs, and visits to relatives/acquaintances, so you are not permitted to perform activities to undertake revenue generating business operations or activities to receive remuneration.

Conditions/Eligibility:

- (1) The applicant's passport must be an Ordinary Machine-Readable Passport (MRP) or ePassport in compliance with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) standard.
- (2) Length of stay of the visa will be up to 30 days for each visit. If the applicant wishes to stay more than 31 days, please call us.
- (3) The applicant has visited Japan at least **once** during the last (3) three years.
- (4) The applicant must have sufficient financial capacity.
- (5) The applicant has appropriate reasons to visit Japan multiple times.

<input type="checkbox"/>	8. Proof of residence such as your California/Nevada Driver's license/ID card, utility bill, bank statements, etc, showing your current address. * You must live in our jurisdiction to apply for your visa. (Northern and Central California & Nevada)

Notes:

- * Please do **NOT** staple or clip your documents.
- * If necessary, additional documents may be required other than the documents listed above.
- * We take a minimum of 5 business days to process. We do not have expedited services.
- * Please note that we may issue a single-entry visa after visa application examination.
- * If multiple-entry visa is not approved upon visa application examination, a flight itinerary & Schedule of stay must be submitted.
- * This list is valid at the San Francisco Office only.
